

Taft College Update

Construction News:



The Transition to Independent Living project continues to move forward with an anticipated completion date of late first quarter, 2013. The parking lot project and campus entrance turnaround is now complete with the exception of landscaping, which will be completed at the conclusion of the TIL construction project. The TIL design team will be meeting soon to review furniture options, and will select furniture, fabrics and other soft finishes within

the parameters of the TIL construction budget. Planning continues for Dorm renovations and a new student center. Lastly, the demolition of the Motorcycle Shop property on 6th Street will begin next week. Abatement of the property will commence September 5th. The demolition activity will begin September 7th and is scheduled to be completed September 14th.



Instructional Program Update:

With the pending departure of Mark Richardson, Superintendent at Taft Union High School District, Marilyn Brown has been appointed as Principal of Taft High School. To continue to strengthen ties with the high school, Patti Bench met with Marilyn this past week to discuss current programs as well as future plans. Marilyn is a long time Taft resident and has extensive experience in curriculum development at our local high school. She is a strong supporter of our College Concurrent Program and looks forward to strengthening our ties and supporting the high school students' participation in this program.

Another passion Marilyn has is in the area of the high school's Oil Academy. The Oil Academy is a flagship program at the high school that is strongly supported by the community, business, and industry. Some of the business partners for this program are the same partners Taft College has with the Energy Technology Program such as Holmes Western, Chevron, Oxy, Aera Energy, Nabors, and others. Marilyn would like to see us develop stronger connections between their Oil Academy and the college's Energy Technology Program. Patti has been invited to attend their monthly advisory committee breakfast later this month to get to know more of their partners and see if we can get their academy leader, Ted Pendergrass to consider joining our advisory committee too.

The third joint project between the college and the high school surrounds the college's welding program. Marilyn and Patti are continuing discussions regarding holding one or two welding classes in their state of the art facility and hope to have the details worked out soon. Our hope is to

offer at least one evening class during the spring 2013 semester, and if that works out, we may add a second class in the fall.
